

HONOURABLE

THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

The undersigned has the honour to report that:

1. Section 10 of The Watershed Associations Act provides as follows:

"10. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may at any time, if deemed advisable for the purpose of ensuring that the several agencies constituting the association will be equitably represented on the board, by order increase or reduce the number of persons to be appointed by any specified agency, and where such an order is made the agency affected shall take such action as may be necessary to increase or reduce its representation on the board, as the case may require."
2. By Your Honour's Order No. 334/89, membership of the Jackfish Lake Watershed Association No. 1 was altered.
3. It is deemed desirable and in the public interest to alter the membership of the Board of Directors of the Jackfish Lake Watershed Association No. 1 by the addition of two members.

The undersigned has the honour, therefore, to recommend that Your Honour's Order do issue, pursuant to Section 10 of The Watershed Associations Act:

- (a) altering the membership of the Board of Directors of the Jackfish Lake Watershed Association No. 1 by adding two members to be appointed by the Rural Municipality of Meota No. 468 to provide representation to the hamlets within the rural municipality;
- (b) confirming that as a consequence of the aforementioned alterations the membership of the Association and of the Board of Directors shall consist of the following:




